

PROGRAM

The camp will consist of teaching basic basketball fundamentals including: shooting, dribbling, passing, rebounding, footwork and defense along with team and transition drills.

Contests will be held in the following areas: hot shot, free throw, one-on-one and three-on-three.

Campers will be divided according to age and ability.

Coach Swartzendruber just completed his first year as head men's basketball coach at McPherson College, following four years as head coach at Hesston College, a two-year, NJCAA Division II college. Prior to assuming the head position at Hesston College, Swartzendruber was head coach at Kingman High School from 1989 to 2004. Following the 2004 season, he was named the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association Class 4A Coach of the Year. He was also named Midwest Sectional Coach of the Year and a finalist for the national coach of the year by the National Federation of High Schools Coaches Association in 2004. He served one term as president of the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association.



Coach Prescott also just completed her first year as head women's basketball coach at MC. Prescott returned home to McPherson after completing her B.S. in sports science at Briar Cliff University. A member of BCU's NAIA II national tournament Final Four team, her playing career was shortened by a series of knee injuries. She then served as a student assistant coach in the Briar Cliff basketball program her final two years in Sioux City. A 2000 graduate of

McPherson High School, Prescott played key roles for the Lady Bullpups' highly successful cross country, basketball, and track programs as Shelly Heinen. Shelly is employed by McPherson Hospital in the Hess fitness center.

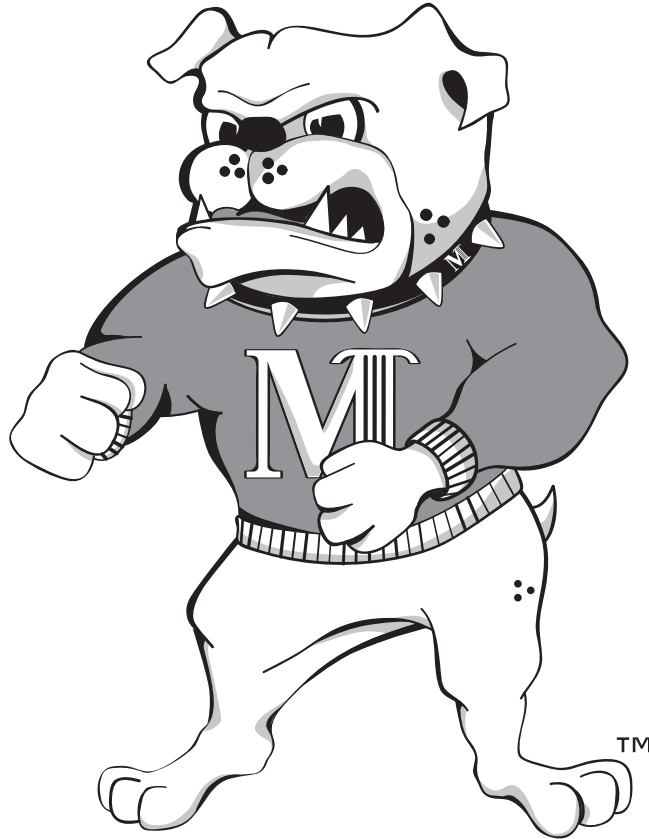

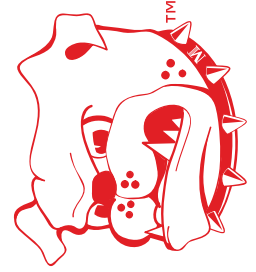
