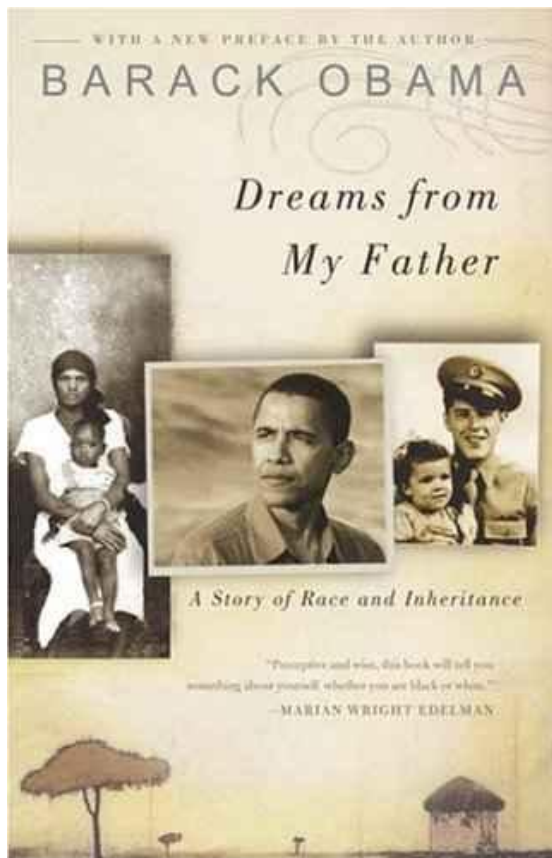
A lecture by Dr. Cheryl Ragar, Kansas State University
